

STARS is the substance misuse service for Staffordshire (excluding the City of Stoke on Trent).

Adult STARS

Adult STARS supports anyone who would like to address their substance and/or alcohol use. We offer the following interventions and links to other providers and services supporting people in different ways including but not limited to:

- 1:1 interventions; identified by client need. Can be facilitated Face to Face, or when agreed, by telephone or Video Call. In addition, we are able to offer home visits when appropriate.
- Clinical service to review Substitute Prescribing.
- Pathways and preparation for Detox or Rehabilitation.
- Signposting to other services/agencies as appropriate.
- Harm Reduction Advice & Information.
- Needle Exchange provision.
- Relapse Prevention.
- Group Work.
- Health and Wellbeing Nurses/Healthcare Assessments.
- BBV Screening & pathways to treatment.
- FibroScans.

The HOPE Team 1-1 sessions for those presenting not requiring longer term interventions.

The HALT Team (North Only) A Hospital Liaison Team specialising in Alcohol referrals from Hospital.

Criminal Justice Team Supporting those who have been released from Prison, subject to Community or Police Orders.

Complex Care Team Working with clients who are street homeless, sofa surfing or at risk of losing property in a holistic strength-based approach.

ICON The Co-occurring pathway is a joint enterprise between STARS and MPUFT, set up to bridge the gap between Drug & Alcohol and Mental Health services working within East and West Staffordshire.

TPS Team (Individual Placement & Support) – a free and exclusive employment support programme for individuals who are with STARS offering support to help find sustainable employment.

Families & Young People

T3 A confidential service for young people in Staffordshire up to and including 20 years of age.

In addition to most interventions offered via the core Adult service, T3 offers:

- One off sessions or longer term structured intervention.
- Community based approach in a comfortable but safe location (home-visits, School/College etc).
- Referrals/signposting to other appropriate services.
- Support if you are affected by someone else's drug or alcohol use (Hidden Harm).
- Specialist Case Manager for young people on the edge of care.
- Specialist Youth Offending Case Manager.

TFSS & IFSS Lite A model designed to work with families experiencing multiple needs and exclusions; but whose primary issue is parental substance use that places children at potential risk from harm. Referrals can only be accepted from children's services.
